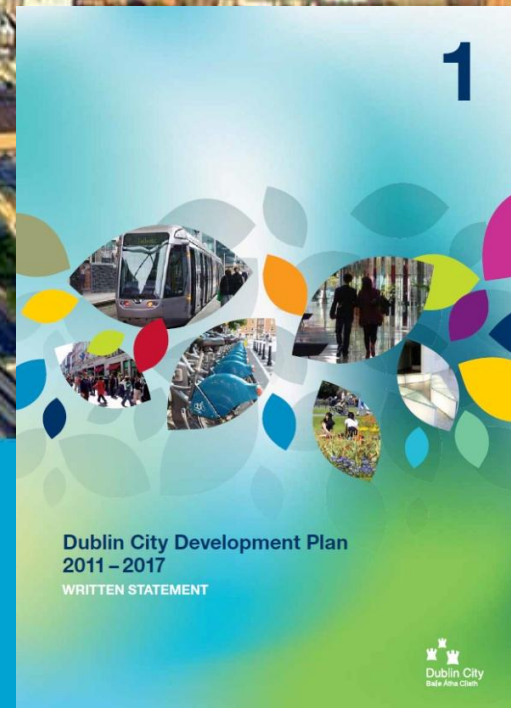

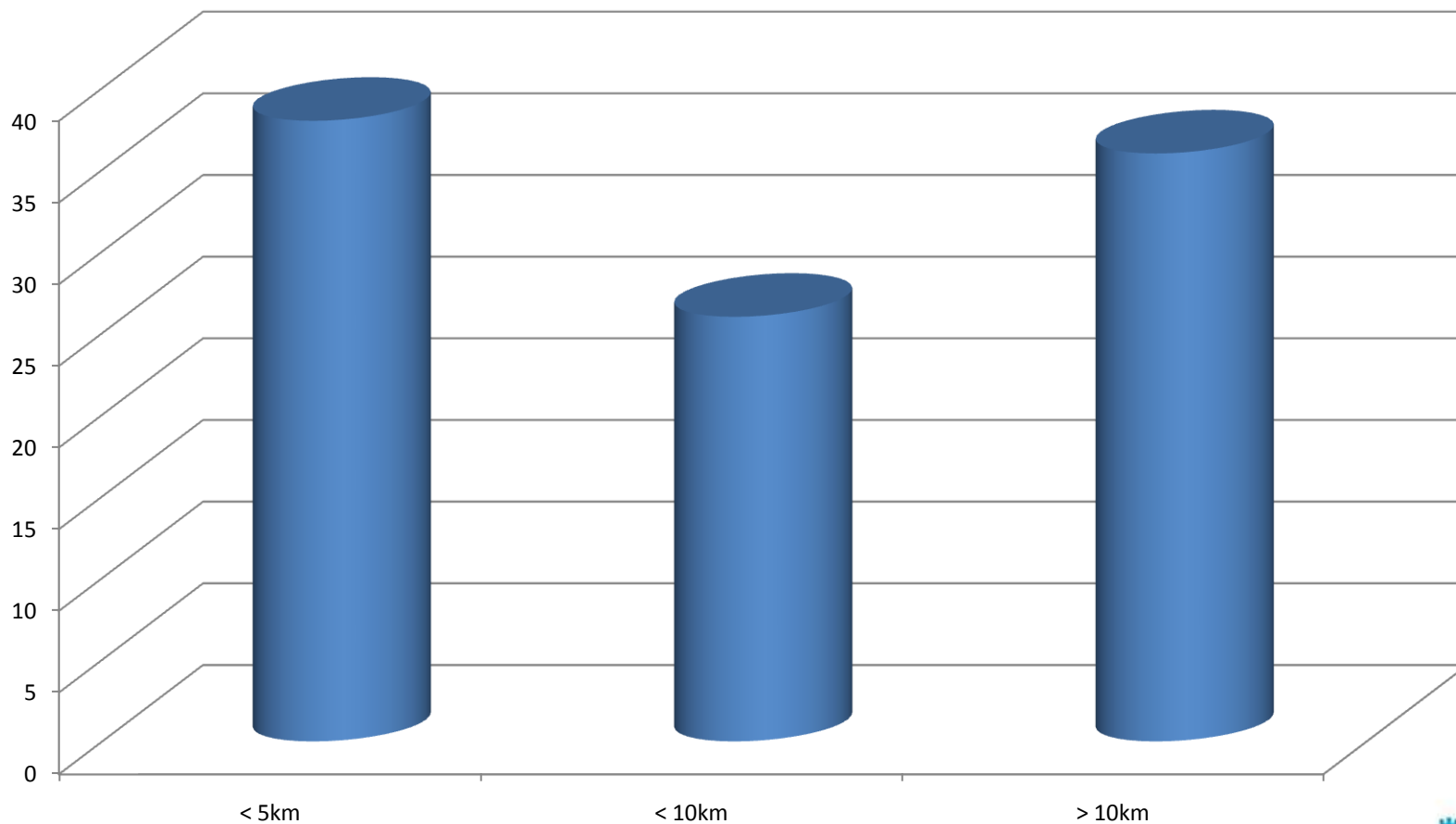

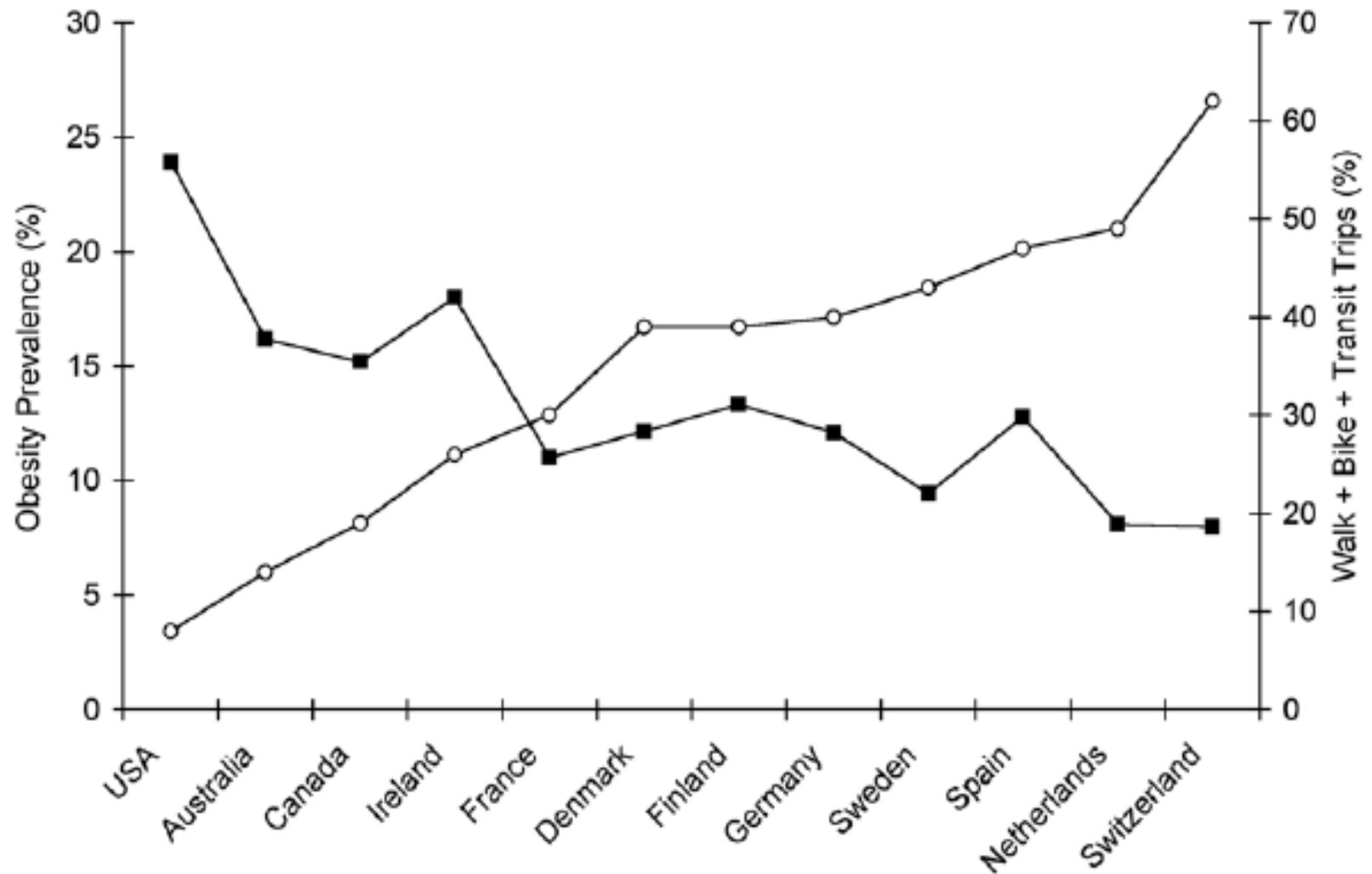




# Travel Distance to Work/Study

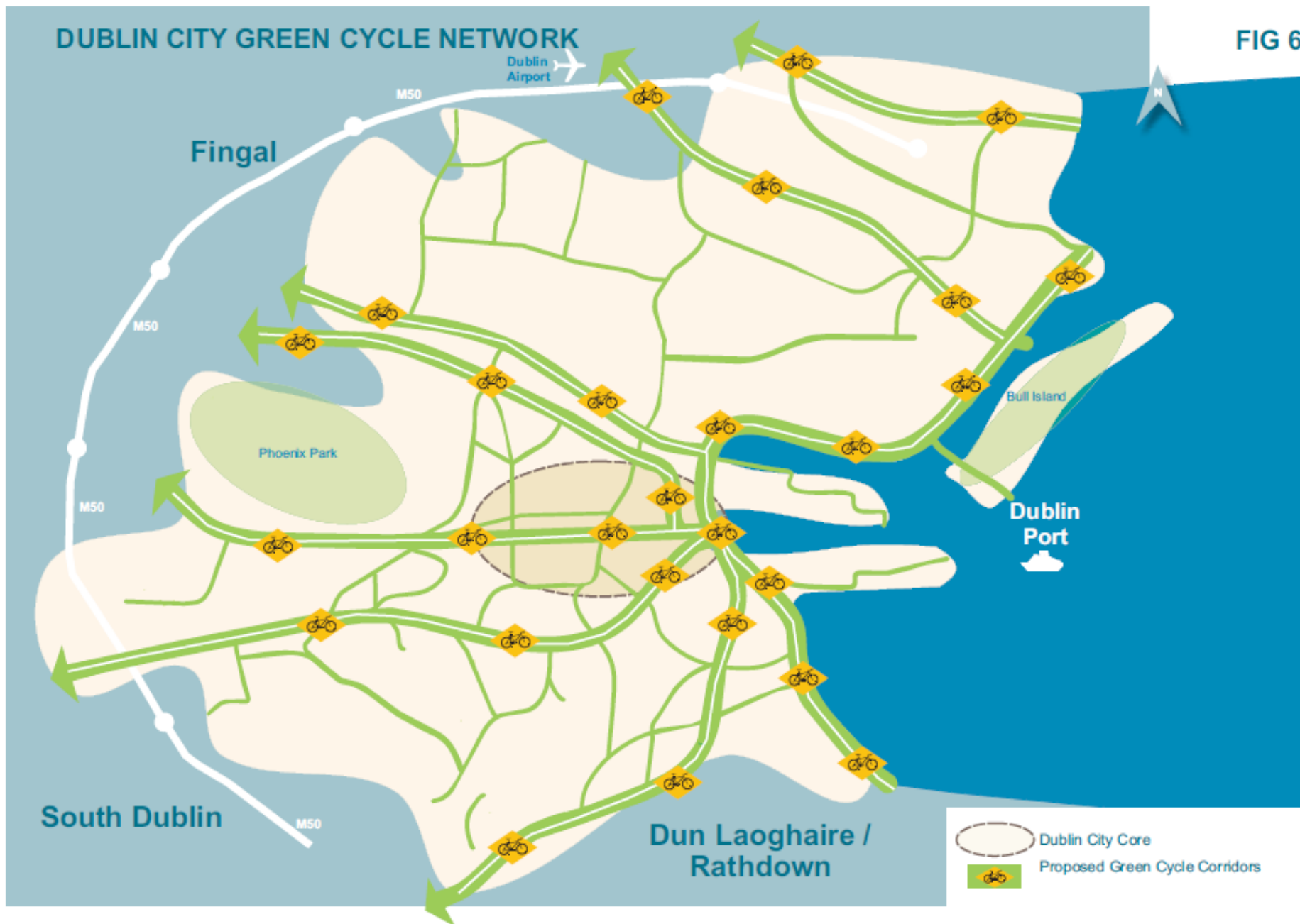

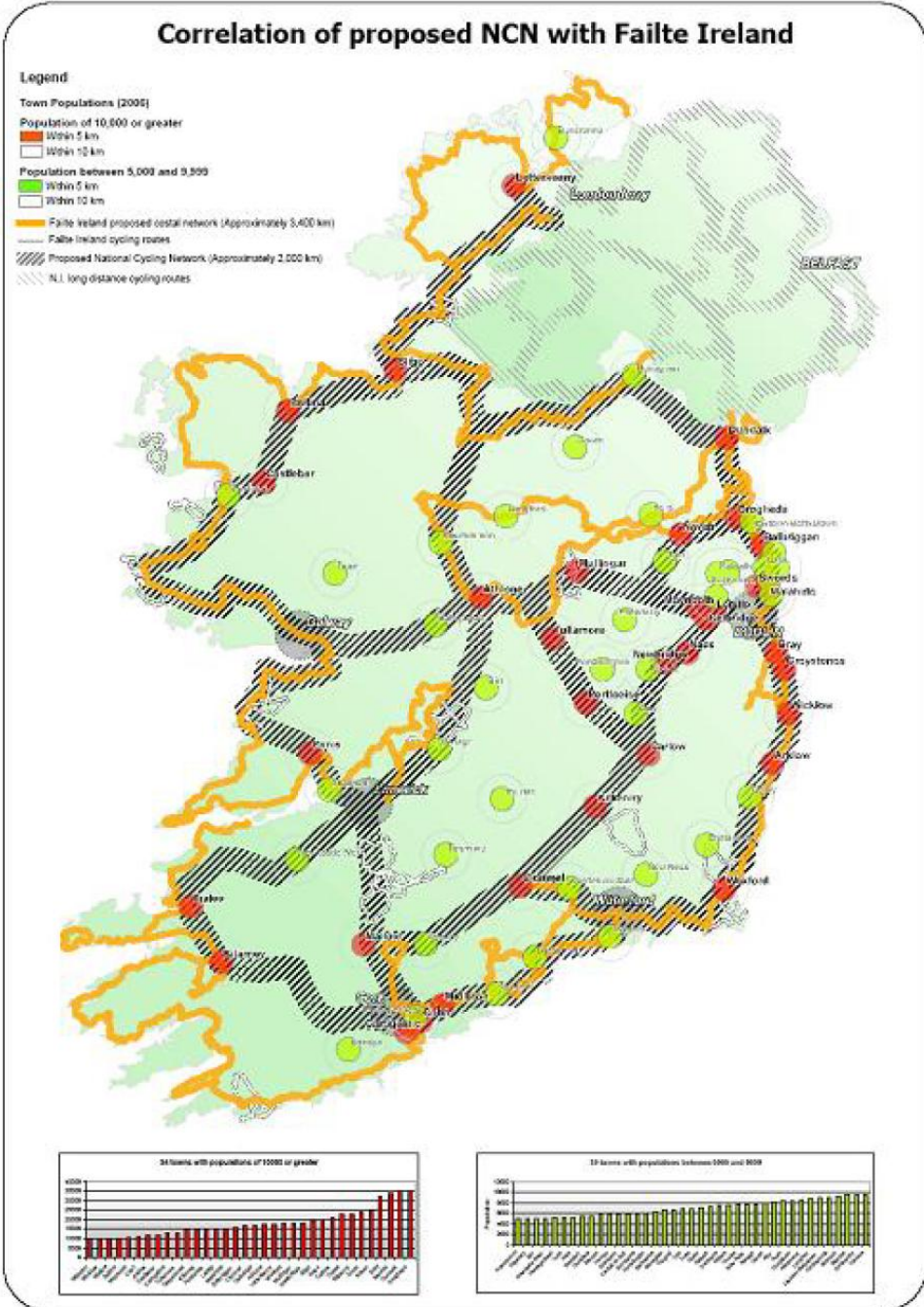


# Grand Canal Green Route



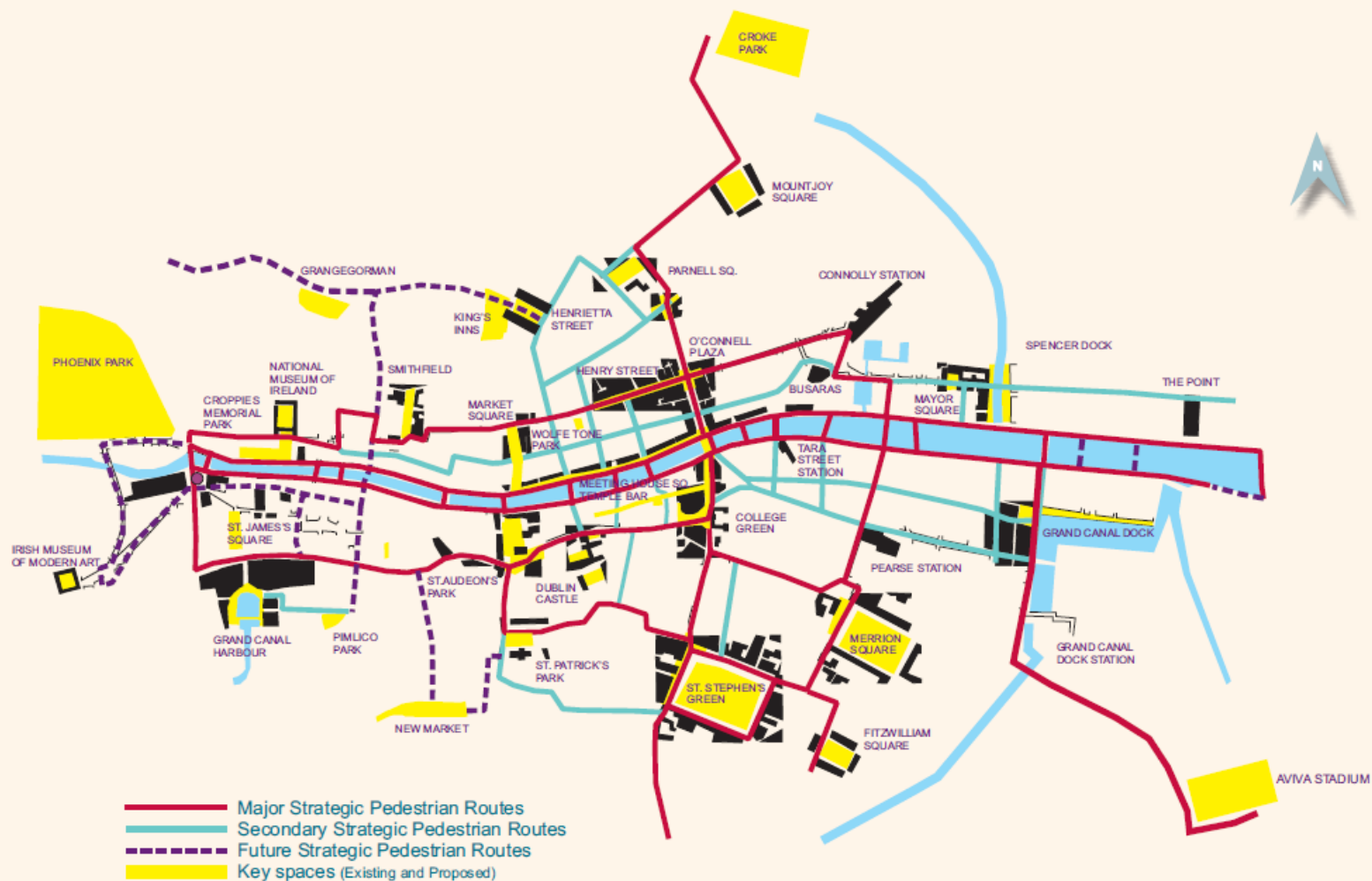


# National Cycle Network Scoping Study

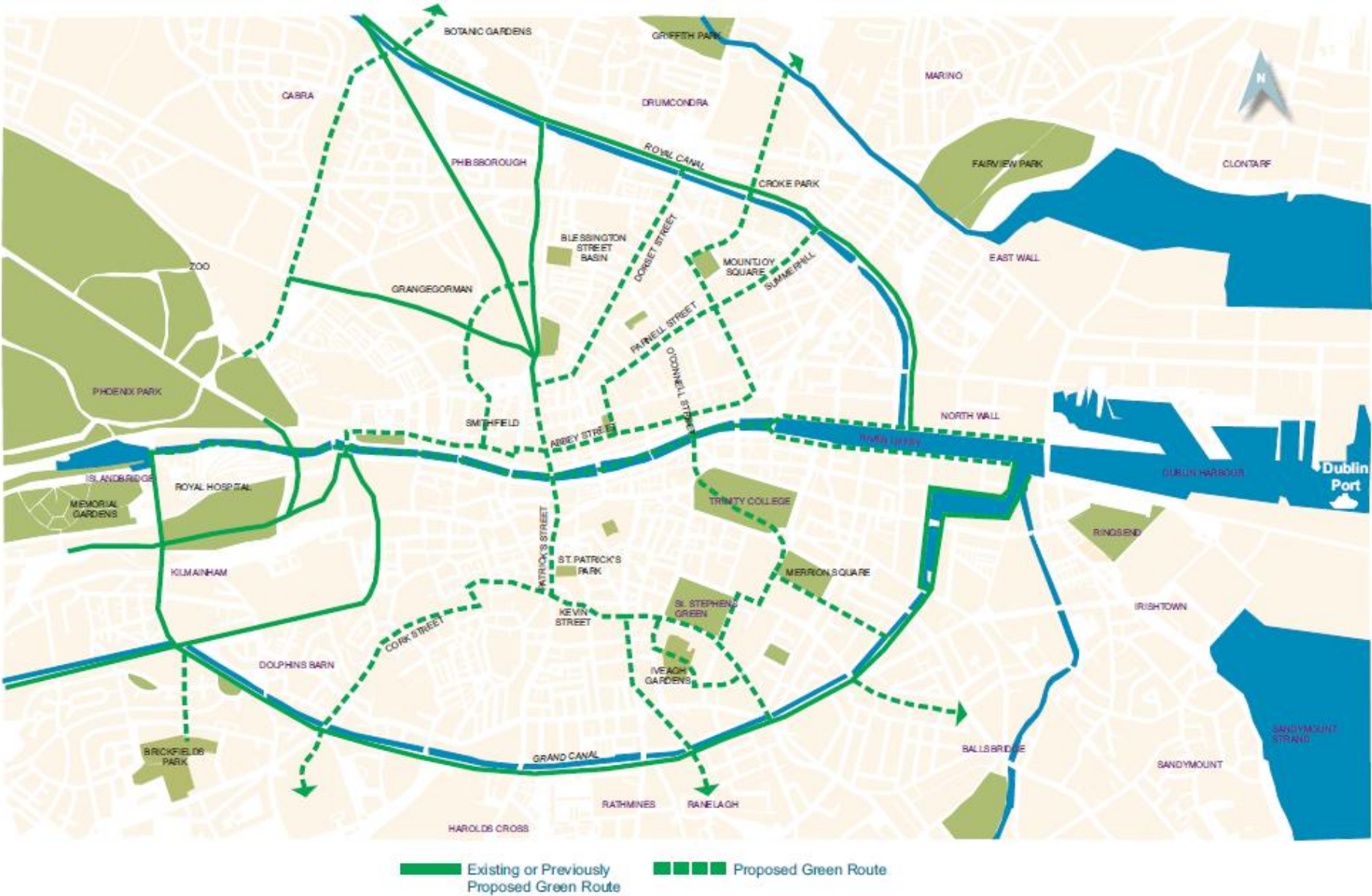

# City Centre Green Routes





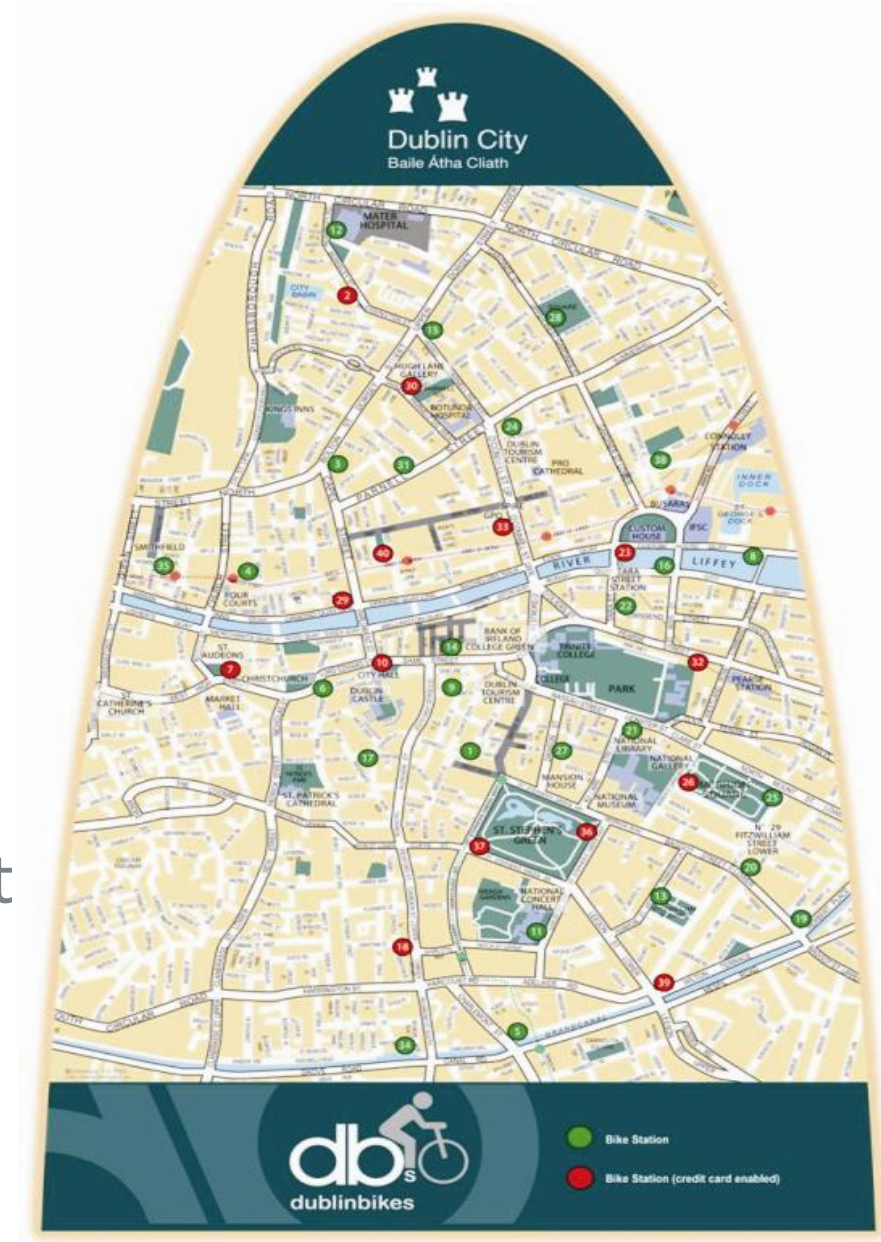

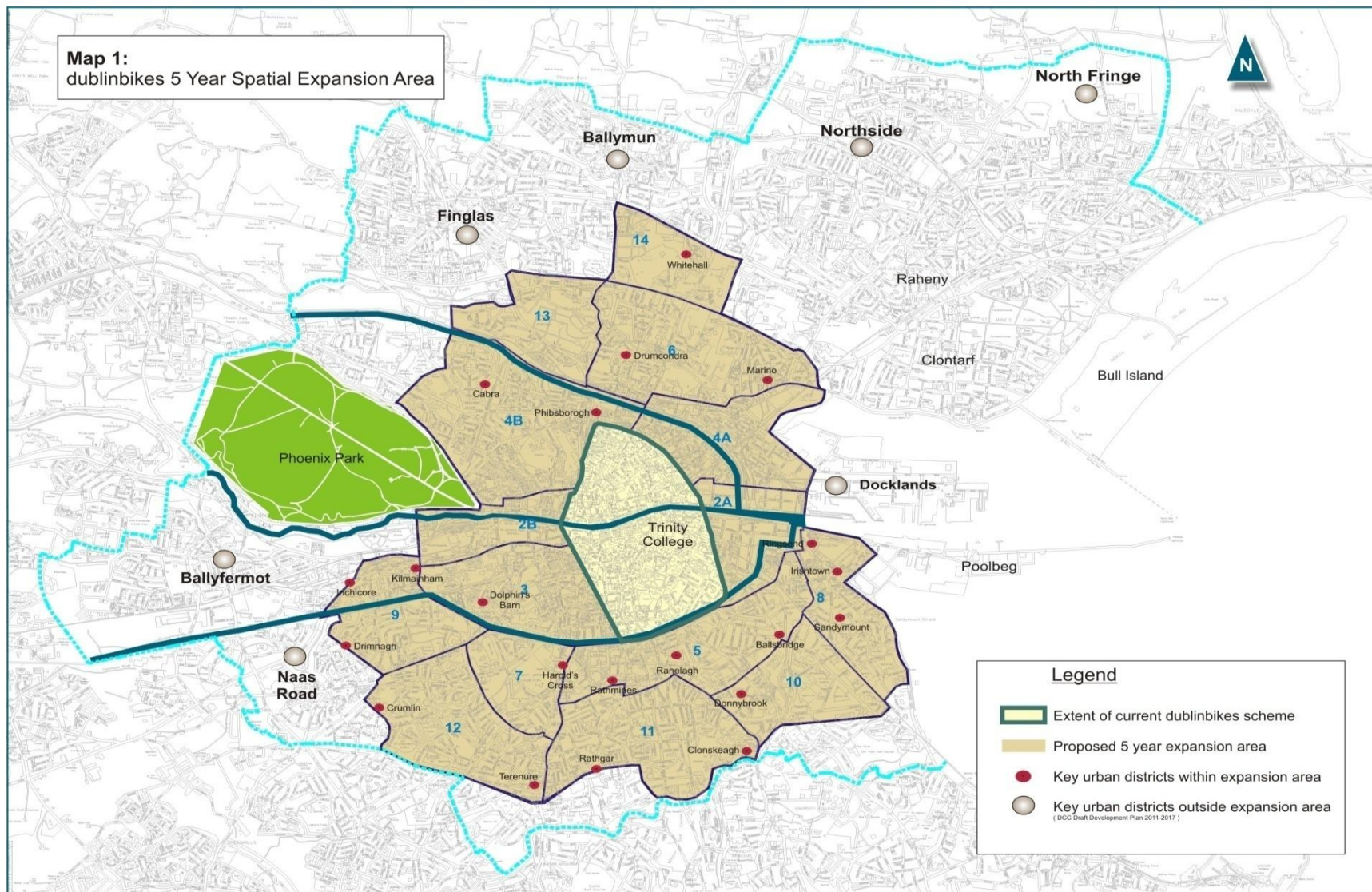
# *'dublinbikes'*

- 'Handy' cited as the main reason for use
- Used in combination with other modes
- 42% 'rarely or never' cycled prior to scheme
- 550 Bikes & 44 Stations
- 5 year expansion strategy
- 5,000 bikes /14 development phases
- Priority Phase 2A  
Docklands/2B Heuston

dublinbikes 5 Year Spatial Expansion Area

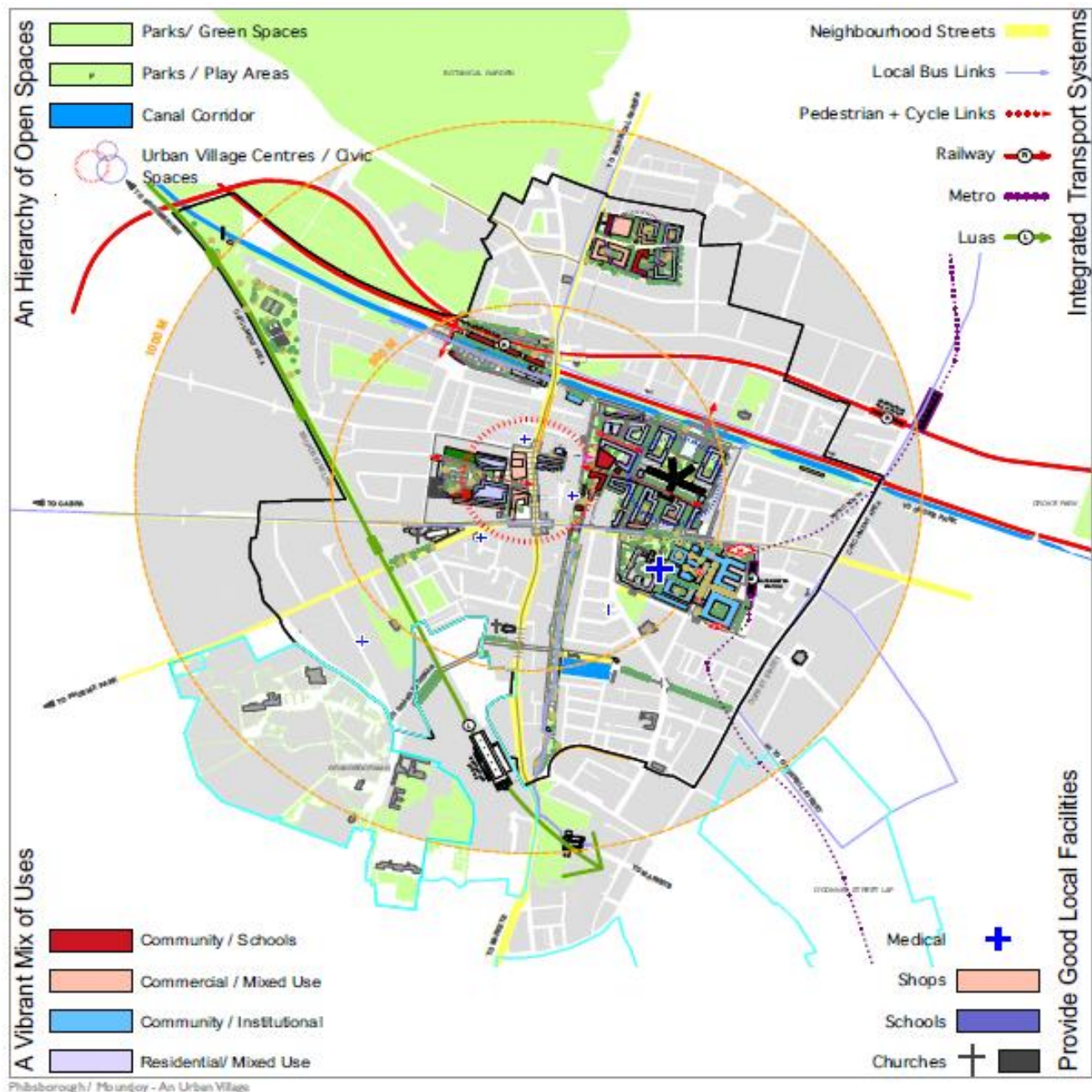
